Vintage Fun Fly Sept 14, 15, 2024

John Ferguson's Report

The first Annual Vintage Fun Fly has come and gone and overall it was a great event enjoyed by all. We had 10 CARFF pilots show up and participate in 4 different events. I was very surprised how close everyone got to the target times or distances in these events. We tried Spot Landing, Timed Flight, Stunt Race, and Glyde Clyde. And lots of open flying time. We had old-timers to brand new wings pilots try each event.

As you will see, the distances and times were all very close. Here are the results;

Spot Landing

1st, Eraldo, 4'11" From Balloon 2nd, Ken, 5'2" from balloon 3rd, Bruce, 6'4" from balloon

Timed Flight

1st, Eraldo, 1.36 seconds from 1 min 2nd, Glen, 3.4 seconds from 1 min 3rd, Rene, 7.2 seconds from 1 min

Stunt Race

1st, Glen, 30.38 seconds total time 2nd, Rene, 35.29 seconds total time 3rd, Bruce, 38.25 seconds total time

Glyde Clyde

1st, Eraldo, 1min 52.25 seconds total glide 2nd, Glen, 1min 49.53 seconds total glide 3rd, Guy, 1min 8.11 seconds total glide

Well that's it. As you can see these guys were all really close to each others results. Not only that, but first to last place scores were very close. Only 10 secs separate 1st from last in the stunt race times, and only 30 seconds first to last in timed flight. Spot Landing saw only 16 feet difference between 1st and last place. Great job you guys, you all showed very good flying skills.

It was a lot of fun and everyone said they had a great time. Guess we need another fun fly like this for sure.

Sep 4, 2024

1. Call to Order: President Glen Peden called the meeting to order at 19:30

2. Agenda: Agenda reviewed and accepted with two additions: Flags, Flight Line. Moved: George, Seconded: Rene. Carried.

3. Minutes of Previous Meeting: Motion to accept Aug 7 minutes as published in the newsletter. Moved: John, Seconded: George. Carried

4. Financial Report:

Chequing Account: Sep 1 balance: \$11,505.91

<u>Anticipated upcoming expenses</u>: Insurance, gazebo roof, website: Total ~\$6,600 <u>Dispute</u>: A buyer has entered a credit card claim for \$100.16 - dispute resolved Sep 4. (Money returned day after meeting, Sep 5th).

5. Old Business:

5.1 Vintage Fun Fly: John discussed the upcoming fun fly and confirmed timers/measurers.

6. New Business

6.1 Assisting new student members build airtime:

Motion: With immediate effect, CARFF will permit club qualified (Wings) pilots to provide flight supervision to student pilots. The supervising pilot must be able to take control quickly; buddy box is optional at the supervising pilot's discretion.

Moved: Glen, Seconded: Eraldo. Carried *Note:* This is in compliance with MAAC MPPD 26, Section 5.7 (first paragraph and "Uncontrolled Airspace - Non Advanced Operations" paragraph.

6.2. <u>Flags</u> are in poor shape: John suggested they be taken down permanently because we are unable to find durable flags. Approved by consensus.

6.3 <u>Flight Line</u> - Resulting from discussions over the season and a recent near miss, methods to reinforce the 7m minimum distance flight-line to pilot stations rule were discussed. Members may recall the unpopular mowing pattern earlier this season.

Motion: That painted lines be laid out by mowing teams to demarcate the near edge of the runway/flight line.

Moved: John, Seconded: Eraldo. Carried.

7. Open Discussion:

Vince congratulated Peter Mitchell on attaining his Wings.

8. Adjournment: 20:40 Proposed: Tim; carried.
